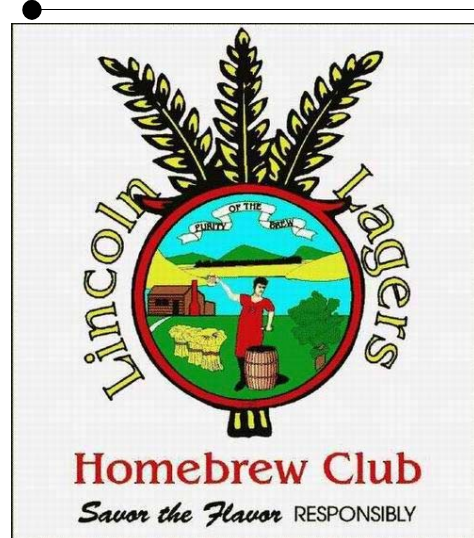
There is still some wort available so let Dave know if you're interested.

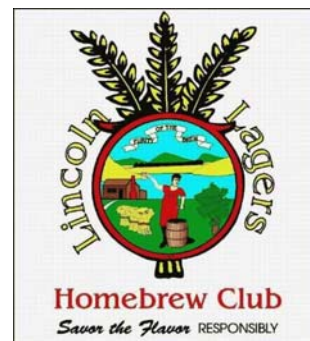
## BEER QUEST
